**The Voivode of Kujawsko-Pomorski Voivodeship Office as a Leader implements the project with the EMIC Foundation as a Partner. The project is co-financed from the National Program of The Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund and is entitled: "You Have the Right to Know!" („Masz Prawo Wiedzieć!”).**

**The project has been carried out is carried for three years (2018-2021), being dedicated to foreigners from outside of the European Union, living in Kujawsko-Pomorski Voivodeship.**

The planned activities assume the implementation of tasks aimed at improving knowledge of the Polish language, increasing access to public institutions, the labor market and to translations and interpretations to Polish, introducing to the rights and obligations arising from the legal order of the Republic of Poland and indicating the possibility of using cultural institutions.

The project also includes adaptation and psychosocial courses.

There will be an information point for foreigners opened in Bydgoszcz and Toruń, providing legal consultation in the field of various areas of law, support in contacts with public institutions, in relations with employers and Polish society. Within the project there will also be a mobile information and advisory point opened, which range of activities will cover foreigners staying in Kujawsko-Pomorski Voivodeship, from outside Bydgoszcz and Toruń.

One of the planned activities is also the education of children and support for schools in the field of working with foreign children.

**Recruitment for the project will be continuous, everyone, regardless of age, will be able to take part in it.**

**EMIC Foundation** – a partner in the implementation of the project entitled "You Have the Right to Know!" („Masz Prawo Wiedzieć!”) – deals with supporting migrants and refugees – people who make their first steps in Poland. The Foundation provides social, legal, psychological, linguistic and integration assistance to foreigners, implementing projects co-financed by the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund as well as the government budget or the EEA Fund.

Previously implemented programs: "Refugees Have A Voice!" („Uchodźcy Mają Głos!”), "Polish Add to Friends" („Polski Dodaj do Znajomych”), "Refugees Have a Voice! Participant. Polyphony. On the Integration of Refugees in Polish Communes" („Uchodźcy mają głos! Partycypator. Wielogłos. O Integracji Uchodźców w Polskich Gminach”).
